MUSIC FOR THE HAPPY END OF FRANZ KAFKA'S AMERIKA

Eine Musiktheater-Performance für Kammerensemble, Sprechstimmen und sechs Kassettenspieler

„Das große Theater von Oklahoma ruft euch! Es ruft nur heute, nur einmal!

Wer jetzt die Gelegenheit versäumt, versäumt sie für immer!“ (Kafka)

Ausgangspunkt der konzertanten Performance ist das letzte Kapitel von Franz Kafkas Romanfragment *Amerika*, zugleich aber auch die Großinstallation **The Happy End of Franz Kafka's Amerika** von Martin Kippenberger, die ab Februar 2021 im Museum Folkwang zu sehen (war) / sein wird und für deren Bespielung diese Performance konzipiert wurde. Unterschiedliche minimalistische „Module“ strukturieren nicht nur die Aufführung, sondern auch die gesprochenen Fragmente des Originaltextes und die räumlich verteilten Einspielungen der Kassettenspieler. Sie beziehen sich somit formal auf die vielteilige, überbordende Installation Kippenbergers. Letztendlich in einem ausgesprochen anti-digitalen „Approach“.



Besetzung:

Flöte, Oboe, Klarinette, Posaune, Elektro-Orgel, Violoncello, Schlagwerk

Für konzertante Aufführungen in anderen end aus einem möglichst großen Fußballpaar unterschiedlichen (leeren) Stühlen als Ensemble gruppieren sich die Musiker und eigneten Tischen / Stehtischen. Die Nummern von eins bis sechs versehen. Die und Starten der Kassetten müssen exakt strukturieren die Aufführung in einer Art bestehen die Zuspielungen aus 48 Kassetten, die in unterschiedlicher Anzahl gleichzeitig gestartet werden. Rahmen ist eine „Ersatzinstallation“, besteh-Teppich, mindestens zwei Tischen und zwei zentrales Bühnenbild erwünscht. Um dies die sechs Kassettenspieler auf sechs ge-Kassettenspieler werden gut sichtbar mit jeweiligen Gänge der Musiker zum Einlegen festgelegt und choreographiert werden und „performativem Verwaltungsakt“. 


Die Deklamation der Texte und Textfragmente durch das Ensemble geschieht durchweg in einer langsamen, überdeutlichen Ausprache und TEXT – VER – STÄND – LICH - KEIT – als imaginativer Habitus – ein „RUFEN ÜBER DEN SEE“ - die Hände zu einem Schalltrichter geformt, ohne mikrofonierte Verstärkung. Im ersten Teil übernimmt die Textperformance ausschließlich das Ensemble. Wünschenswert ist eine permanent wechselnde Aufteilung der Textfragmente (entsprechend den „Textboxen“) auf die verschiedenen Spieler. Im zweiten Teil übernimmt zum größten Teil ein vorproduzierter Sprecher durch Kassetten-Zuspielungen.
